



# Infectious Disease TESTING at Dent County Health Center

## RAPID COVID-19 ANTIGEN TEST

Results In 15 Minutes or Less

**Acon FlowFlex Antigen – Test free from State - \$10 Administration fee**

**QuickVue - \$15 per test plus \$10 Administration Fee = \$25**

**BD Veritor - \$15 per test plus \$10 Administration Fee = \$25**

*Antigen tests are more likely to give a false negative result, but can usually be trusted if they are positive. If you have symptoms and receive a negative antigen test, we recommend following up with a more sensitive PCR test. **QuickVue is more sensitive than BinaxNow***

## RAPID COVID-19 and INFLUENZA A&B ANTIGEN TEST

Results In 15 Minutes or Less

**BD Veritor - \$25 per test plus \$10 Administration Fee = \$35**

**Lifesign - \$29 per test plus \$10 Administration Fee = \$39**

## RAPID COVID-19 Molecular TESTS

Results in 30 minutes or less

**ID Now – NAAT – Highly accurate and affordable = \$50 **Now in stock!****

**LUCIRA Check It – NAAT – Highly accurate = \$105 **In stock****

**CUE NAAT – Highly accurate = \$95**

*PCR and Nucleic Acid Amplification tests use advanced molecular techniques and are more accurate than antigen tests. However, false negatives are still possible early on in the disease course of COVID-19. It's recommended to wait until you've had symptoms for at least 24 hours before being tested. These tests are usually suitable for travel.*

## **SEND-OFF Tests**

### **Results in 1-5 Days**

**SEND-OFF PCR (STATE PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY)** – Results in 1-2 days – PRICE: **Free after antigen test, but must meet certain criteria**

**SEND-OFF PCR (LABCORP)** – Results in 1-2 days – PRICE: **\$88**

**SAR-CoV-2 IgG/IgM antibody test** – Requires Provider Orders - **\$88**

## **Other RAPID Antigen Tests**

Results In 15 Minutes or Less

**Influenza A/B – \$25**

**Streptococcus - \$10**

## **Other Rapid Molecular TESTS**

Results in 30 minutes or less

**ID Now – Strep = \$39**

**ID Now – Influenza A/B = \$59**

**ID Now – RSV = \$49**

- Testing is currently being conducted in the isolation room in the center of the building. There is a separate entrance to the testing room with HEPA filtration.

## **HOW TO GET FREE TESTING**

- If you have insurance, you must provide your insurance card and information, including SSN, unless you don't have an SSN.
- If you don't have insurance, you must sign the no-insurance attestation form (can be done in the Kiosk) and provide your SSN, unless you don't have an SSN.
